# Credential Evaluation – Basic Principles

- Validity of the credential
- ‘Official’ nature of the documents
- Level of the qualification
- Conversion of credits (quantification of education)
- Conversion of grades (quantification of performance)

# Validity of the credential

- Who does it belong to?
  - Does it belong to the individual who presented it for evaluation?
- What does it represent?
  - Eg. Completion of the program, or award of a qualification?
- Can this be used in the home country for academic purposes?
  - What is required domestically?

# Official Documents

- Are they issued by the appropriate institution?
  - What is the appropriate office or institution?
- Does it have any security features?
  - Stamps, seals, signatures, etc.?
- How was it issued and delivered to you?
  - Sent directly, sent electronically, copied, submitted by applicant?
- Is it authentic?
  - Does it represent the work actually earned? Is the performance assessment accurate? Is the translation correct?

# Determining the level of the qualification

- Resource libraries
  - Print, electronic, periodical, databases, conference materials
  - Country pages and sample documents
- Electronic resources
  - Published by ministries and other governmental authorities
  - Published by US non-governmental organizations
  - Published by non-US non-governmental organizations

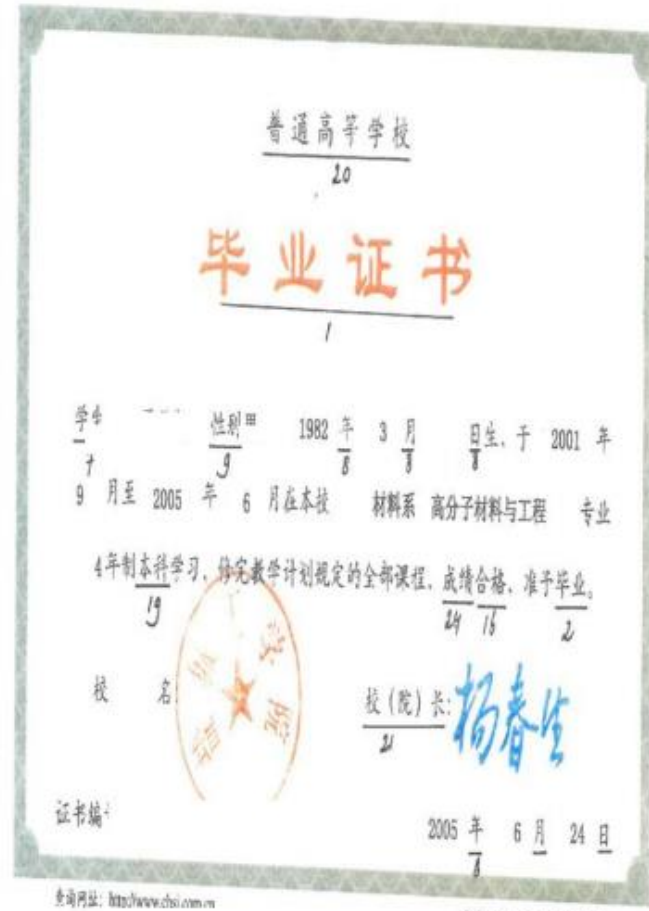

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## Belgium : Overview

The Kingdom of Belgium is located in Western Europe, bordering the North Sea. It shares borders with France, Germany, Luxembourg and the Netherlands. It is about the size of Maryland and, with a population of slightly more than 10 million people, is one of the most densely populated countries of Europe. The capital of Belgium is Brussels.

On 4 October 1830, Belgium declared its independence from the Netherlands. It is a federal parliamentary democracy under a constitutional monarch. As a result of a 1993 constitutional revision, there are three levels of government (federal, regional and linguistic community) with a complex division of responsibilities. The official languages of Belgium are Dutch (60%), French (40%) and German (less than 1%).

Education in Belgium falls under the authority of the linguistic communities—Dutch, French and German. Dutch and French are the predominant languages of instruction. Thus, much of the power over educational policies and their implementation lies with the Cultural Council of the Flemish (Dutch) community and the Cultural Council of the French community.

The Belgian Constitution grants the right of education to everyone. To promote this right, education in Belgium is compulsory between the ages of 6 and 18 years of age. This compulsory education is free of charge. The communities provide pre-school (nursery school), primary school, secondary schools and technical schools. Vocational and technical education begin at the secondary education level, as does art education.

Although the educational system is divided by language, there are some shared requirements. A law passed on 20 January 1981 listed several subjects that are compulsory during primary education. And, since 1989, the core curriculum is very important at the secondary education level. Access to tertiary education is available to anyone who has completed secondary education.

Tertiary education—university education and non-university higher education—in Belgium is the responsibility of the Flemish and French communities. Each community has its own Ministry of Education. Even so, the traditional structures of tertiary education are similar, with the same degrees/diplomas being awarded by both systems. Now, however, with the introduction of the Bologna Process, this is changing.

The Flemish Parliament passed The Act on the Structure of Higher Education in the Flemish Community on 4 April 2003. This piece of legislation started the process to reform the Flemish higher education system. The old and the new structures will co-exist, with the old structure being gradually phased out by 2011. In March of 2004, the French community adopted a law that reorganizes the higher education system to make it compatible with the European Higher Education Area. The application of the new structure was scheduled to begin in September 2004, with the old structure being phased out by the academic year 2007-2008.

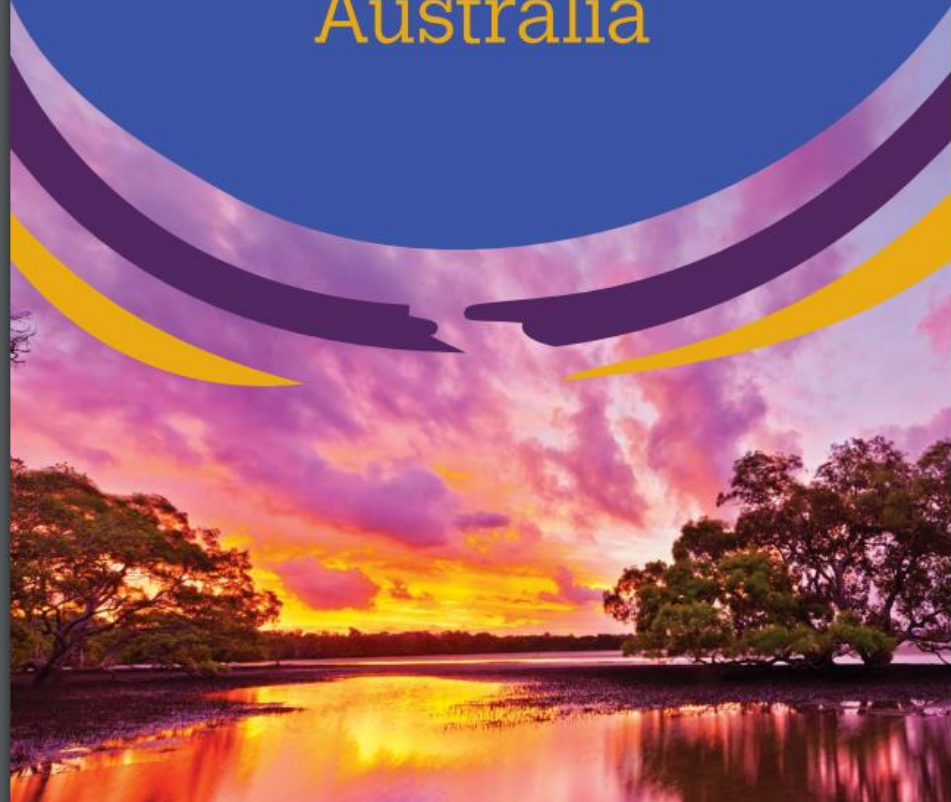

# Conversion of Grades

- Most common grading system in the US is the A-F scale
- Overall performance is represented in the form of a GPA
- GPA = a mathematical average of all course results factored by the designated weighting of each course
  - Different than a major subjects GPA, overall grade, CGPA, qualification result, etc.
- Online tools can be immensely helpful

# Conversion of Grades – Grading Scales

- Grade conversion scales differ
- Grades are interpretive and qualitative
- Scales can be tailored to suit an institutional purpose – consider the source.
- Considerations:
  - Word descriptors
  - Classifications
  - Highest grade possible, and minimum pass
